

Diocesan Youth Event Packing and Schedule

Friday: Registration opens at 7pm and the main program starts at 8pm on Friday night.

You can arrive as early as 7 if you need to because of travel. If you are on the Diocesan youth council or Leadership for the event you can arrive after 5pm.

Friday night we play some get to know you games, music, smores at the bonfire and Compline

Saturday: A Christian formation time in the morning followed by camp free time; such as hiking, sports, arts and crafts, workshop and movies. A youth led prayer service and a dance with Board games.

Sunday: Closing Slideshow, songs and a group picture happen at 10:15. Pick up is at 11am.

Packing:

- Bed Roll including pillow
- ToothBrush, toothpaste, deodorant, shampoo, soap
- Layered Clothing--It can be cool on the mountain in the evening
- Medications in plastic bag with name on it and instructions to give to nurse
- Water Bottle with your name on it

Do Not bring:

- Expensive Electronics
- Snacks
- Knives, weapons, drugs, alcohol or tobacco products

Behavior Expectations: We will be living in community for three days and as such, we need to agree to some things that will make our life together run smoothly.

1. Youth are only allowed to sleep or be present in the cabins they are assigned to.
2. Do not bring offensive clothing.
3. No inappropriate sexual activity.
4. No alcohol, illegal drugs, tobacco products, fireworks, or weapons are allowed at anytime.
5. No person is to leave during the event without permission from the event coordinator. (It is the expectation that youth will stay for the entire event.)
6. Please do not bring snacks. Many will be provided.
7. Full participation in all events is expected. If one does not feel called to participate at all times their presence and respect is still expected.
8. **Cell Phone Policy:** Cell phones brought will be kept by adults at the weekend. There will be a box at registration for all cell phones. This is in order for us to have a more restful and safer retreat.
 - a. During AYE and Winterstar a time will be made available to check out your phones out on Saturday usually from 11am-2pm. All phones will be collected again after this time and returned to youth after the event is over.
